



In order that our clients and contacts are up to date with our coverage of tax and business developments, we have enabled RSS feeds on our website. For those who have not previously used this facility, RSS feeds enable you to receive an automatic message direct to your computer every time our website is updated with a new article or feature. RSS stands for "Really Simple Syndication", and is used quite extensively, for example RSS feeds can be obtained from the BBC News website.

RSS feeds are free, and there are a number of ways to receive them. Firstly, we have not forgotten **Apple Mac** users, who can always find our feeds at:

Onto Windows users now:

➤ **If you have Microsoft Office Outlook 2007:**

Skip to Page 3 of this guide, where a complete 2-page guide (6 steps) to setting up Burgess Hodgson RSS feeds in Outlook 2007 can be found.

➤ **If you have Microsoft Office Outlook 2003 (or Internet Explorer 7 or 8):**

Read on and follow steps 1 through to 5, on this page and the next. Even though Outlook 2003 doesn't contain an RSS reader, there are other programs that allow you to view RSS Feeds. We recommend that you use Internet Explorer 7 or 8, both of which enable you to view RSS feeds. Here is how you set up Internet Explorer 7 or 8 (the procedure is the same for both versions):


- 1) First of all, type in www.burgesshodgson.co.uk in the address bar at the top, and go to our website.
- 2) Once our web page has loaded, click on the now orange (was grey!) RSS feeds icon (circled in the screenshot below).



- 3) Now click on "**Subscribe to this feed**".

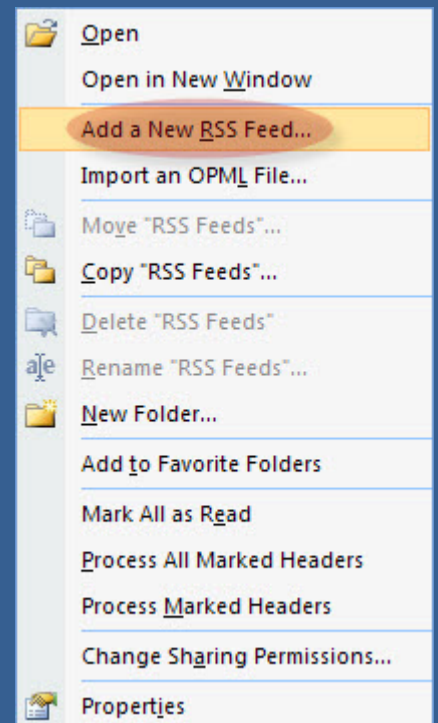

1. In Outlook 2007, in the navigation pane on the left-side of the screen, right-click on “RSS Feeds” (highlighted in the red circle in the screenshot to the left).

2. In the menu that now appears, left-click on “Add A New RSS Feed” (highlighted in the red circle in the screenshot to the right).



3. In the box, enter the following as the location of the RSS feed you want to add to Outlook:

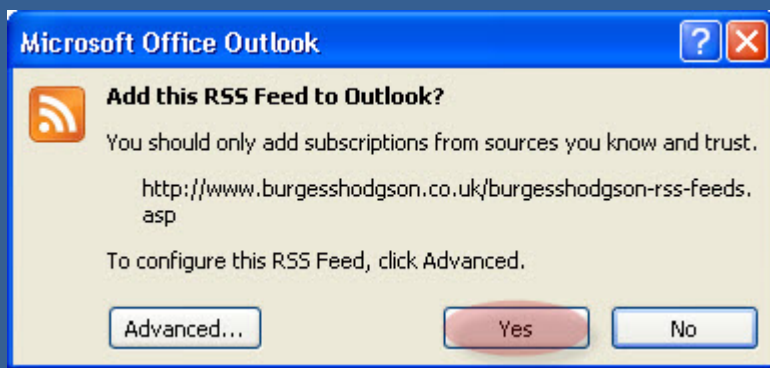

4. Left-click the “Add” button.



5. Confirm to add the RSS feed to Outlook 2007 by clicking the "Yes" button (as highlighted in the red circle below).



6. Wait a moment while Outlook 2007 does a Send/Receive to obtain all the Burgess Hodgson RSS feeds. When complete, you will see the list of BH RSS feeds in chronological order as below, and for each feed you have the option to "View Article" (highlighted in the red circle below), which when left-clicked will take you directly to the relevant article on the Burgess Hodgson website.
